ke ali‘i	the chief or chiefess
ke aloali‘i	the royal court
ke Aupuni	the government; country
ka hana	the work, doings, events
ke kamāli‘iwahine	the princess (= <i>kama + ali‘i + wahine</i> )
ke kanikau	the dirge, lament
ke kino	the body
ke kono	the invitation ( <i>kono</i> = to invite)
ka lāhui	the people of the nation
ka makahiki	the year
ka Mō‘ī	the ruler (king or queen of a whole country)
ka mua	the first
ka noho	the chair ( <i>noho</i> = to sit, to live somewhere)
ka nohoali‘i	the throne (= <i>noho+ali‘i</i> ); rulership
ka palapala	the document, letter ( <i>palapala</i> = to write)
ka wahine	the woman, female
ka wā	the time period
hala	to have passed (of time or a person)
hiwahiwa	to be highly esteemed
holo‘oko‘a	all together; completely; all
kanalima	50
ki‘eki‘e	to be high; tall; majestic
make	to be dead
piha	to be full, complete
pū	together, with something
hana	to work (see <i>ka hana</i> )
ho‘ohiwahiwa	to honour, to make <i>hiwahiwa</i>
ho‘okō	to fulfill; to execute a duty
komo	to enter; to go inside something
kono	to invite (see <i>ke kono</i> )
noho	to sit; to live or stay somewhere (see <i>ka noho</i> )
palapala	to write (see <i>ka palapala</i> )

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
