Put the number at the front of the sentence before the subject, just like we do in English. For example, five people = 'elima kanaka.

Ho'omākaukau, kahi, lua, kolu... 'o ia

Ho'okahi pae mauna = one mountain range

'Elua mea = two things

'Ekolu kapua'i = 3 feet

4 kanaka = 4 people

5 kukui = 5 candelnuts

6 humuhumunukunuku'apua'a - 6 humuhumunukunuku'apua'a fishes [no need "fish" in Hawaiian]

7 hala - 7 panadanus

8 maka'āinana = 8 commoners

9 nalu - 9 waves

10 hoaaloha - 10 friends

11 wahine - 11 women

12 kāne - 12 men

13 kanawika - 13 sandwiches

14 hola - 14 hours

15 lā - 15 days

16 pō - 16 nights
